During ADW, Fontein & Bova presents a range of new collections and material innovations that highlight the brand's craftsmanship and technical expertise.

Recently, we launched the RV Collection in collaboration with Belgian design studio RV Architects. This collection includes both dining and coffee tables and is distinguished by its unique *Patina di cemento* inlay. This cement-based finish — commonly used in pool architecture, particularly in Southern Europe — is unlike Mortex or similar techniques. The inlay is seamlessly integrated into a solid wood frame, making it a technically demanding process. During ADW, the collection will be further expanded with a matching RV bench. In addition, we are exploring new material applications, including an RV table with leather inlay and an optional leather leg.

The introduction of the Renée lighting collection marks the next step in the brand's evolution. While we have traditionally focused on furniture, this collection extends our design expertise to lighting. It translates our existing wood finishes and colorways into lighting elements, creating a coherent and refined overall aesthetic. Other collections will gradually be complemented with matching lighting.

We also recently introduced the HighGloss finish, a luxurious technique that gives walnut wood a remarkable depth and layered effect. Due to the complexity of the process, this finish is applied by only a select few specialists, reinforcing the exclusivity of our approach.

Since March, the Jules Desk and Jules Cabinet have joined our collection. Both pieces are characterized by refined leather inlays and subtle accents, resulting in a sophisticated yet understated luxury.

Alongside HighGloss finishes, we are seeing a strong resurgence of solid-color finishes in contemporary interiors. Responding to customer demand and current trends, we have been experimenting extensively with this finish. During ADW, we will showcase several pieces in these finishes, including a deep red tone that is increasingly popular in interior design. In addition to standard colors, any RAL or NCS color can be realized on our designs, and these can also be combined with HighGloss finishes for a bold and luxurious effect.

Story / History

Fontein & Bova stands out for its expertise in coloring and finishing solid wood. In addition to a carefully curated selection of standard oak and walnut finishes, we offer bespoke color solutions, even matching 1:1 with a supplied sample or an existing piece of furniture. This capability is one of our core strengths.

All finishes — from solid colors to HighGloss — are applied entirely in-house by our skilled craftsmen. This year, we have focused even more on refining our HighGloss techniques, where craftsmanship meets precision.

Fontein & Bova is a young Belgian brand with full production in its own workshop in Flanders. Founder Pieter-Jan (31) represents the fourth generation carrying forward the family knowledge and passion for woodworking. As a trained wood technologist, he combines hands-on expertise with deep technical knowledge of wood and its properties.

We deliberately collaborate with Belgian partners for textiles and leather, reinforcing our commitment to quality and local production.

In 2028, the brand will celebrate a milestone: 100 years since the founding of Fabriek Fontein in 1928. The name F&B is a subtle homage to this rich family history in furniture making and timber trade, referencing the merger of Fabriek Fontein, Bossuyt, and Van Weynsberghe.
